**STAYING AHEAD OF THE CURVE: CPCU SOCIETY DALLAS SYMPOSIUM TO
SPOTLIGHT KEY REINSURANCE ISSUES**

Texas Railroad Commission Chairman Elizabeth Ames Jones to Speak

MALVERN, Pa., Aug. 22, 2011 — Reinsurance professionals will soon have a unique opportunity to stay out front of the latest trends in a turbulent economy.

On Wednesday, Sept. 28, the CPCU Society and the Reinsurance Interest Group will present a symposium on "Current Issues Facing the Industry." **The symposium will take place at the Hilton Anatole-Dallas, 2201 N. Stemmons Freeway, Dallas, Texas.**

The Second Annual Dallas Reinsurance Symposium will feature an executive panel moderated by CPCU Society President-Elect Steve McElhiney, CPCU, MBA, ARe, AIAF, as well as updates on regulatory and emerging issues, reinsurance claims and more. Elizabeth Ames Jones, chairman of the Railroad Commission of Texas and candidate for the U.S. Senate, will deliver the keynote address at a luncheon generously sponsored by CSC.

The symposium will be held from 8 a.m. to 4:50 p.m., followed by a cocktail and networking reception from 5 to 6 p.m. Experts will discuss many topics, including the current state of the industry, recent litigation/arbitration decisions and their effect on reinsurance contract wording, the future of insurance regulation, and the impact of the recession on reinsurance recoveries.

For CPCU Society members, the cost is \$175. For ARe designation holders and Southwestern Insurance Information Service (SIIS) members, the cost is \$195. For nonmembers, the fee is \$225. The registration fee includes continental breakfast, all refreshment breaks, luncheon and a cocktail reception.

The Dallas symposium is approved for three continuing education (CE) credits, and filed for one CE credit in Texas. The program has been filed for six CLE credits in Texas. CPCUs will be awarded 6.5 continuing professional development (CPD) points for attending this symposium.
